This Wednesday will be Pink Shirt Day. Pink Shirt Day is an annual event where people wear pink or red to signify our commitment to treating others with kindness. As part of our school goals, we are working on helping everyone in our community feel welcome. Simple acts of kindness such as smiling, holding open a door, saying hello, and helping each other are ways that we can work together to help everyone feel safe at school.

At the same time, there may be incidents at school, and it can be confusing to know if it is a conflict or if it is an example of bullying. While we recommend that if you have a concern that you reach out to your child's teacher, we thought the chart below might be helpful for families when we look at the language we use to describe the incident.

What's the difference between <b>CONFLICT</b> and <b>BULLYING</b> ?			
<b>Conflict</b> happens occasionally and is usually not serious or emotionally damaging to either person.	<b>Bullying</b> is unwanted, aggressive behaviour that involves a real or perceived power imbalance. The behaviour is <b>repeated</b> and <b>purposeful</b> .
