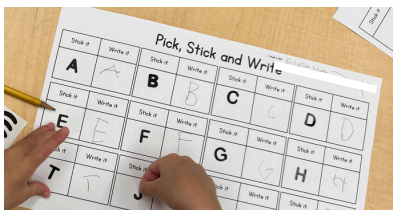
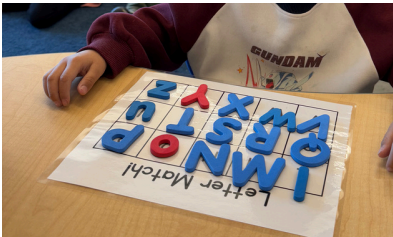


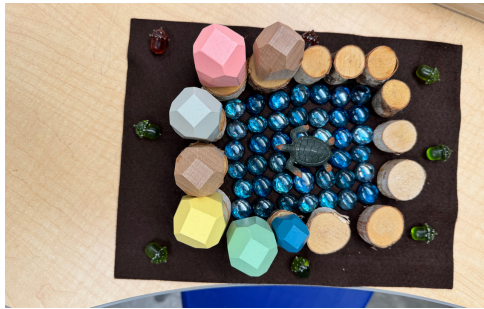
Exploring Literacy Centers

in a K/1 classroom

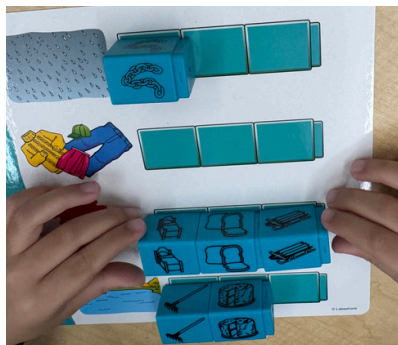
Students are exploring letters by identifying and matching uppercase and lowercase forms to strengthen their letter recognition skills.



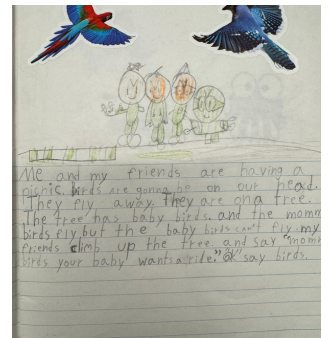
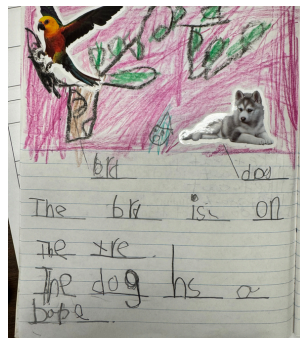
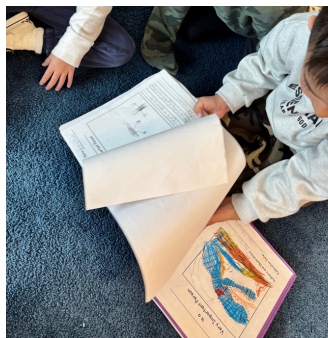
Students are using loose parts to retell stories from Foxy and Friends and to create their own, incorporating key story elements: character, setting, problem, and solution.



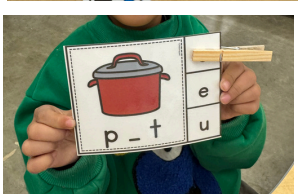
Students are practicing identifying syllables and rhyming words to build their language skills.



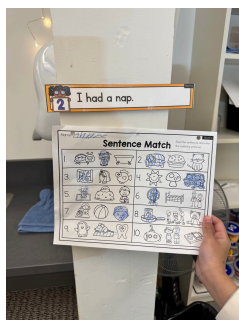
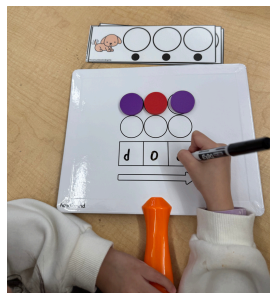
Students are creating their own books to add to our classroom library and creating stories with stickers.
