Dear Families,

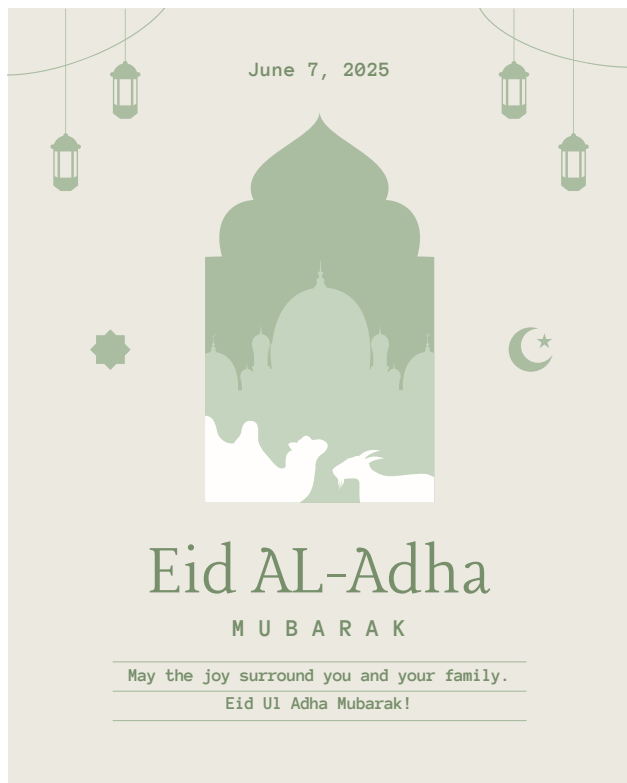
